



GROUND REGULATIONS (HEREINAFTER "RULES")

1. Scope

These Ground Regulations (hereinafter „Rules“) together with the relevant local laws shall apply to all persons who enter the stadium premises used in connection with the ongoing mass event according to the law of Poland (hereinafter „Match“). Stadium premises shall include all venue areas, including all entrances and exits, as well as all other official areas and facilities (hereinafter „Stadium“) that are accessible with a Match ticket or other admission document determined by Organiser.

2. Entrance

- 2.1 Persons may only enter the Stadium with a Match ticket acquired and used in compliance with the ticketing terms and conditions, unless otherwise authorised to do so by Organiser. Match ticket acquired or used in breach of ticketing terms and conditions shall be void and any person seeking to use such Match ticket will be deemed a trespasser and will be refused entry or be evicted from the Stadium, and may be liable to further legal action.
- 2.2 Entrance to the Stadium shall only be authorised upon presentation of a valid Match ticket per person (regardless of age) and, upon request, proof of identity (such as ID, passport, driving license, student card, school card). The Match ticket as well as proof of identity must be shown and handed over for inspection on entry and inside the Stadium at the request of any steward, safety personnel and/or any other legally authorised persons representing the organizer of the Match. Failure to cooperate shall result in access to the Stadium being denied or expulsion from the Stadium.
- 2.3 Minors under the age of 13 shall only be authorised to enter the Stadium with an accompanying adult.
- 2.4 Driving and parking of vehicles inside the Stadium and/or within the Stadium perimeter shall only be permitted with the special authorisation of Organiser.
- 2.5 The validity and usability of Match tickets shall be determined according to the ticketing terms and conditions.
- 2.6 There is no re-admission to the Stadium.

3. Personal controls

- 3.1 Stewards or police shall be entitled to examine – including through the use of technical aids – whether persons represent a security risk, in particular whether they have consumed alcohol or drugs or are in possession of weapons or other prohibited items. Stewards or police shall be entitled to search any person's clothing and other items in their possession.
- 3.2 Persons who make an unauthorised use of Match tickets, who do not follow the instructions of Organiser (or any official appointed by Organiser) or any steward or police officer at the Stadium, or who represent a security risk or who are subject to a local, national or foreign Stadium ban shall be denied access to the Stadium and shall immediately return their Match ticket to Organiser, all without refund.

4. Conduct inside the Stadium

- 4.1 All persons entering the Stadium shall:
 - a) conduct themselves in such a way that they do not harm, injure, endanger or unnecessarily obstruct or annoy others, nor cause damage to anything;
 - b) follow the instructions of Organiser (or any official appointed by Organiser) or any steward or police officer present at the Stadium;
 - c) occupy the seat allocated to them as described on their Match ticket and use the appropriate access routes. If any person becomes aware of any damage caused to any property or any accident of any kind such person should take immediate steps to inform Organiser (or any official appointed by Organiser) or any steward or police officer at the Stadium.
- 4.2 Further exceptional demands may be made in order to prevent, reduce or eliminate danger to life, health or property. Instructions issued by stewards or police must be followed and failure to cooperate may result in expulsion from the Stadium.

5. Sound and image recordings and transmissions

- 5.1 Any person attending a Match consents to being photographed, filmed or taped by the Organiser and/or by any third parties appointed thereby, which shall have the right to use, broadcast, publish and license, without any requirement for payment of money or other form of consideration, of such person's voice, image and likeness by means of live or recorded video and/or audio display, broadcast or other transmission or recording, photographs or any other current and/or future media technologies.
- 5.2 Any person attending a Match shall not take, record and/or transmit any sound, image and/or description of the Stadium or Match (as well as any result and/or statistics of the Match) other than for his/her exclusive, private and domestic use. It is strictly forbidden to disseminate over the Internet, radio, television or any other current and/or future media, any sound, picture, image, data, description, result and/or statistics of the Match in whole or in part, or to assist any other person(s) conducting such activities.

6. Prohibited items and conduct

- 6.1 The following items may not be brought into the Stadium:
 - a) weapons or explosives of any kind, including anything that could be adapted for use as a weapon or to cut, thrust or stab with, or as a projectile. This includes any fireworks, flares, smoke powder, smoke bombs or other pyrotechnics;
 - b) bottles, cups, jugs or cans of any kind as well as other objects made from PET, glass or any other fragile, non-shatterproof or especially tough material;
 - c) alcoholic beverages of any kind, drugs, stimulants or psychotropic substances;
 - d) racist, xenophobic, vulgar, provocative, religious or political propaganda objects or materials;
 - e) any promotional or commercial objects or materials;
 - f) flagpoles or banner poles of any kind. Only flexible plastic poles and so-called double-poles that do not exceed 1 metre in length and 1 cm in diameter are permitted;
 - g) gas spray cans, corrosive, flammable substances, dyes or re-ceptacles containing substances which are harmful to health or are highly flammable. Standard pocket lighters are permitted;
 - h) professional cameras, video cameras or other similar devices;
 - i) unwieldy objects such as helmets, ladders, stools, (folding) chairs, strollers, boxes, large bags, rucksacks, suitcases and sports bags. For the purposes of this rule, „unwieldy“ means any objects which are larger than 25cm x 25cm x 25 cm and which cannot be stowed under the seat in the Stadium;
 - j) large quantities of paper and/or rolls of paper, streamers, confetti;
 - k) mechanically or manually operated sound-emitting devices such as mega-phones, klaxons, vuvuzelas, air-horns, trumpets;
 - l) laser pointers;
 - m) sport balls, beach balls, balloons;
 - n) drones and other items that may disrupt the Match. The above list is not exhaustive. In case of any doubt with regards to any object being brought to the Stadium, the relevant steward or official appointed by Organiser shall be responsible for defining which objects are prohibited or permitted.
- 6.2 Unless expressly authorised by Organiser the following items may not be brought into the Stadium:
 - a) animals;
 - b) banners or flags larger than 2.0 x 1.5 metres. Smaller flags and banners are permitted provided that they are made from material which is deemed „non-flammable“ and comply with national regulations and standards. The above list is not exhaustive. In case of any doubt with regards to any object being brought to the Stadium, the relevant steward or official appointed by Organiser shall be responsible for defining which objects are prohibited or permitted.
- 6.3 It is strictly forbidden to do any of the following inside the Stadium, without limitation:
 - a) throw objects or liquids of any kind, particularly in the direction of another person or in the direction of the area around the pitch or pitch itself;
 - b) start a fire, let off or launch fireworks, flares, or other pyrotechnics;
 - c) express or disseminate political, religious, racist, xenophobic, vulgar propaganda and pursuits or slogans and emblems;
 - d) act in a way which may be interpreted by others as provocative, threatening, discriminatory or offensive;
 - e) sell goods and tickets, distribute printed material and hold collections or carry out other promotional or commercial activities without prior written authorisation from Organiser (or any official appointed by Organiser);
 - f) enter the pitch or the area around the pitch;
 - g) climb on or over structures and installations not expressly intended for that use;
 - h) write or paint on or affix anything to structural elements, installations or pathways;
 - i) relieve oneself anywhere other than in the toilets, or litter the Stadium by discarding objects such as rubbish, packaging, empty containers, etc;
 - j) stand on seats in the spectator areas;
 - k) any other conduct which is prohibited or is dangerous or threatening.
- 6.4 Unless otherwise authorised to do so by Organiser (or any official appointed by Organiser), it is strictly forbidden to do any of the following inside the Stadium, without limitation:
 - a) access areas (e.g. function rooms, VIP, and media areas, etc.), which are closed to the public or for which access is unauthorised;
 - b) restrict or loiter in areas open to traffic, footpaths and roadways, entrances and exits to visitor areas and emergency exits;
 - c) any other conduct which is not authorized.
- 6.5 Any breach of the Rules may result in the following penalties being imposed:
 - a) expulsion from the Stadium and possible handing over to the police;
 - b) cancellation and invalidation of the Match ticket and banning of the offender from all next matches organised by Organiser;
 - c) provision of the relevant personal information to respective national football associations and/or the police so that appropriate measures can be taken, e.g. national stadium bans;
 - d) initiating by Organiser or any other authorised persons or entities of legal proceedings;
 - e) any other penalties or remedies in accordance with applicable laws. Organiser reserves all other rights to pursue other legal remedies at its own discretion.
- 6.6 The Organiser reserves the right to change the date and time of the match in case of so-called force majeure, especially when this is due to weather or other causes beyond the control of the Organiser.

7 Liability

- 7.1 Any person attending a Match acknowledges that he/she does so at their own risk and that he/she may be liable for damage or loss resulting from any of his/her acts at the Stadium.

8. Severability and amendments

- 8.1 Should any provision of the Rules be declared void, ineffective or unenforceable by any competent court, the remainder of the Rules shall remain in effect as if such void, ineffective or unenforceable provision had not been contained.
- 8.2 Organiser reserves the right to make reasonable amendments to the Rules from time to time, the latest and effective version of which shall be available on www.pzpn.pl and at the Stadium.
- 8.3 During the Match (mass event), these Rules shall take precedence over the internal rules of the Stadium.

9. Authentic text

- 9.1 The Rules have been drafted in Polish and translated into English. In the event of any discrepancy between the text, the Polish text shall prevail.

10. Applicable law and jurisdiction

- 10.1 The Rules shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of Poland.
- 10.2 All disputes arising from or related to the Rules shall be submitted to the competent court in Poznań.
